

# Lead Safe Information

## EPA Requirements

On April 22, 2010, the EPA issued a new rule requiring the use of lead safe practices to prevent lead contamination on any home, child care facility, or school built before 1978. All business's performing renovation, repair and painting projects to any of the items listed above must be certified and must abide to all lead safe practices and guidelines.

Biddeford Painting is an **EPA Certified Lead Renovator** and also an **EPA Certified Firm**. All of our crews hold current certifications and must have their documentation with them while on the job site. There are two valid certifications; Renovation, Repair and Painting (RRP), which is the initial certificate and Renovation, Repair and Painting Refresher.

Certified Lead Renovators are required to supply the Home Owner with a **Renovate Right Pamphlet** and a **Pre Renovation Form** at least 7 days before renovation.
